vii) A description of the method and significant assumptions used during the year to estimate the fair value of options including the following information:

- a. Fair value of the options is calculated by using Black-Scholes option pricing model.
- b. Stock price: The closing price on NSE as on the date of grant has been considered for valuing the options granted.
- c. Volatility: Volatility is a measure of the amount by which a price has fluctuated or is expected to fluctuate during a period. The measure of volatility used in the Black-Scholes option-pricing model is the annualized standard deviation of the continuously compounded rates of return on the stock over a period of time. The historical volatility of the stock till the date of grant has been considered to calculate the fair value of the options.



- d. Risk free interest rate: The risk free interest rate on the date of grant considered for the calculation is the interest rate applicable for a maturity equal to the expected life of the options based on the zero coupon yield curve for Government Securities.
- e. Time of Maturity/ Expected Life: Time of Maturity/ Expected Life of option is the period for which the Company expects the option to be live. The minimum life of a stock option is the minimum period before which the options cannot be exercised and the maximum life is the period after which the options cannot be exercised.
- f. Expected dividend yield: Expected dividend yield has been calculated on the dividend prior to the date of the grant.
